	<p>This plate shows when, where and by whom the carriage was BUILT.</p>	
	<p>This small reservoir holds OIL to help keep the engine running smoothly.</p>	
	<p>This is an early UNDERGROUND MAP showing the stations of the Metropolitan Railway in London.</p>	
	<p>During the Second World War everyone had to carry a GAS MASK .</p>	
	<p>This PRESSURE GAUGE shows the engine driver the level of steam pressure in the boiler.</p>
